

## 2020 Skins and Pins for NAMI Metro

### Celebrating 15 years of this great event!

#### UPDATES & CHANGES for this year due to COVID 19:

Your Safety is our greatest concern this year and the Skins and Pins Committee working in conjunction with Fox Hills and in adherence of CDC guidelines and the state's Emergency Orders have implemented the following necessary changes to ensure a safe event:

- For those who may be uncomfortable about attending the meal we have arranged for an option for people to get a \$25 Gift Card for Fox Hills that can be used for food, golf, etc. with no expiration date. **We need to know this in advance though if you prefer the gift card over sitting for the meal.** You must let us know if want the Gift Card and will not be staying for the meal by Sunday, July 19, 2020 if that is your preference, and we understand if that is your choice. You will still have opportunities to participate in prizes if you chose to opt for the gift card over the meal. If you don't stay and win something, we will hold it for you and arrange to get it to you or give it to another person that you choose to take it for you.
- Other than when out golfing or when seated for the meal, **Fox Hills and NAMI-Metro is asking everyone to wear a mask for the protection of everyone.** We will have masks available if you do not have one or forget yours. PLEASE, put your mask on at check-in, as soon as you enter the clubhouse, and if you stop at a bar on the course or interact with anyone working on the course. The only times that you should remove your mask are when you are alone with your golf group on the course or seated for the meal, and even then, please practice social distancing with no contact to the best extent possible.
- **Everyone** will check-in at the Golden Fox, Including those from the Strategic. Bag drop will not be available, so you must take your own clubs to your cart. There will be a board posted to find your starting hole number and to check yourself in. The carts for the Strategic golfers will be set up at the Golden Fox, so you can keep your car parked at the Golden Fox. Your 2020 Ball Marker and 15th Year Gift will be in your goody bag and in your cart waiting for you
- Please pay online prior to the event to avoid extra touch points at check-in. You may also purchase raffle tickets, 50/50 tickets, and cards online in advance and we will have them ready for you when you arrive. *(These will also be sold the day of, but as follows)*

- **Raffle tickets will only be sold prior to golf.** Raffle prizes will be set up in the club house bar, and **all purchased tickets must be dropped into the prize bags before you head out to golf.** All Raffle prizes will be drawn starting at 11:30am, during golf, so anyone not golfing can also stop by before 11:30 to enter. Winning Raffle numbers will be posted on boards by the prizes and online at [skinsandpins.org/raffle](http://skinsandpins.org/raffle). Please check your tickets and pick up any winning items as soon as you return from golf and put them in your car.
- **50/50 Tickets and Cards will be sold on the course during golf and at one station in the clubhouse after golf** (Because of the changes in the raffle we will not sell these at check in this year, but you can purchase them online in advance and we will have them ready for you to pick up after golf). You will find girls wearing the RED hats selling 50/50 tickets.
- There will be One Putting Contest this year held on the Golden Fox Putting Green next to where you will check in.
- **While golfing, the flag sticks should never be pulled or touched.** The bottom of the flag stick has a new piece that keeps your ball up to easily remove it. If you mark your name on a contest marker, we recommend the use of some sanitizer right after. There will be hand sanitizer in everyone's goody bag.
- Due to State Orders, Fox Hills is unable to do the traditional five-star Sunday brunch. Instead, we will either be having a plated meal, delivered to you by staff servers, or food stations where your food will be served to you. The Champagne cannot be put out this year either but will still be served by the staff. Also, all drinks must come from servers as there will be no service at the bar.
- All tables will be set up for 8 this year and will be socially distanced 6 feet apart. If you tell us who your group of 4 would like to be paired with for the meal, we will accommodate all requests and encourage that you let us know who to seat you with.
- All auction items will be online only this year with pictures and descriptions on line. This applies to both the live and silent auction. You will be able to bid right from your phone at your table or wherever you are if you don't stay for the meal, and prior to the event as we plan on opening the auction a couple of days early. All auctions will close at 3:00pm sharp on the day of the event!

- If you win an auction item, you will be able to checkout online or if you need assistance checking out, someone will come to your table to check you out, but it will probably be faster if you check out yourself, so please have patience with our volunteers.
- With all of these changes this year, we expect the meal period/presentations to move much quicker, so please remember – all raffles before golf, pick up winners right after golf, buy 50/50 & cards either in advance, on the course, or after golf, and bid for auction items online until 3:00.
- All volunteers will be wearing masks and wearing gloves when handling anything. Our objective is to reduce handling and contact of anything by all to a minimum out of an abundance of caution. ***Please remember if you get up from your table to put your mask back on.***
- ***This has been a tough year for all of us and we feel lucky to be able to hold the event this year, but we want it to be a safe one, above all – so please do your part in adhering to these changes this year and hopefully we will be back to normal in 2021! Thank you!***
